






Audi Malaysia recalls 2,767 cars on Takata airbag issue

The new Audi distributor in Malaysia, PHS Automotive Malaysia (PHSAM) has announced a voluntary recall for 2,767 of Audi cars that were fitted with Takata airbags or gas generator for the airbag unit on the driver's side, passenger side and the curtain. Based on the manufacturer's latest update, there is a potential that the gas generator housing may be damaged if the airbag is deployed. This could cause small metal parts to become dislodged from the housing and this poses a serious safety risk.




This exercise involves Audi A4 Sedan, A5 Sportback, A6 Sedan, Q5 and TT Coupe models manufactured between 2008 and 2017. According to PHSAM, owners of the vehicles are urged to bring their cars to any Audi Centre for a complimentary inspection and replacement of the parts, if necessary.

"At Audi, safety is paramount, and this will continue to be one of the distinguishing factors in our ongoing efforts to improve aftersales service. 




